Exercise FAQs

There will be states at many different stages of vaccine planning participating in this exercise. Feel free to include anyone who is important to your vaccine planning efforts.

How do you envision state teams participating during the exercise?

We suggest state teams try and join the virtual sessions from the same room if at all possible **following their local COVID-19 guidelines.** Regardless of participants joining individually or as a group, we will ask groups to designate one speaker to represent each state. We have already heard from some states who know they will be unable to attend the exercise together locally. They are planning to hold internal state planning meetings in advance of the exercise. This is certainly not a requirement, but we wanted to share with the larger group.

Will the topics & questions for the exercise be shared ahead of time?

Yes, we will be sharing a full list of questions in advance. Each group will have the time to meet internally and discuss with their stakeholders in preparation for the exercise.
